

Chemical Engineering III - Marking System

The exam will consist of two parts:

1. A **written test** aimed at testing your problem solving skills. The test will be administered by your tutors (Dr. Basarova and Dr. Grof) and it will consist of calculations similar to those you practiced during the tutorials. You can achieve **up to 50 points** from the written test, but you have to achieve **at least 20 points** in order to proceed towards the oral exam.
2. An **oral exam** aimed at testing your theoretical understanding. This will take place in Prof. Stepanek's office (building B, room S64) and you need to sign up on-line via Student Information System (student.vscht.cz) for one of the set dates. During the exam, you will randomly draw two questions from a list of topics that were covered during the lectures. You will 30 minutes for preparation and then approximately 30 minutes for the actual exam. You can achieve **up to 50 points** from the oral exam (up to 25 per question). In order to pass the oral part, you must achieve **at least 20 points**.

Your total points score will be the **sum of the written and the oral parts** and the final mark for the course will be allocated as follows:

To summarise, you must achieve a total of **at least 50 points** in order to **pass overall**, but also **no less than 20 points from each part** (written and oral).
